To the esteemed Director and distinguished meteorologists,

We are a non-profit organisation from Singapore and Malaysia. Our main efforts include monitoring and mitigating major global disasters, especially those that pose a big threat to humanity. At the same time, we urge people to protect Mother Nature and improve their self-cultivation. We predicted that from 2019 onwards, disasters would occur worldwide in continuous succession with increasing intensity. These factors compel some of us to put aside our jobs and seek solutions to reverse this trend so as to save Life and our Earth.

From the third quarter of 2019 till early this year, we have focused our efforts on putting out wildfires in countries such as Russia, Brazil, Greenland, Alaska, Gran Canaria, and Australia with rains. If interventions were not taken to put out the severe forest fires near the Arctic Circle, the fires would further accelerate the melting of glaciers in Greenland.

August 2019: 13 million hectares of forests in Siberia, Russia, were razed in just 7 months. At that time, the area covered by smoke produced by the fires was almost 2800 kilometres long. Russia's meteorological bureau forecasted that in the following weeks, there would be no rains strong enough to reduce the fires. We commenced our endeavours on 11 August, and predicted that the fires would be extinguished by 24 August. In just 13 days, continuous rainfall that was not forecasted by the meteorological bureau doused the fires. Even after extinguishing the flames, the rains continued for a period of time to enable the rain water to seep deep into the parched soil, so as to cool it and speed up the recovery of the soil after being damaged by the intense fires.

August to September 2019: 470,000 hectares of Brazil's Amazon rainforest was burnt in May 2019. In July 2019 alone, the area of the forest burnt was 4 times bigger than that of July 2018. The Amazon is akin to the Earth's lungs; if the fires were to continue ravaging the forests, it would exacerbate the already severe global warming issue. At that time, the media reported that rains would only happen in October. On 14 August, we began to put our efforts into it and predicted that the forest fires in the Amazon would be successfully put out on 6 September 2019. Unfortunately, many fires in the Amazon were ignited by people. Hence, although heavy rains extinguished the fires, we observed that the fires began burning again along the fringes of the Amazon rainforest from 7 September again. This illustrated that fires were started by people wishing to clear the forested lands.

January-February 2020: As of January 2020, bushfires in Australia burnt down 10 million hectares of land, and an estimated 1 billion animals perished or were injured in the fires. The Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) and other mainstream media publications reported that the

drought conditions would last till April or May. In the meantime, there would be no rains strong enough to stop the fires. They also urged people residing in Australia to make preparations for more severe bushfire conditions ahead. At that time, we concluded that if these fierce fires were not put out, Australia would not only experience food shortage, some parts in Eastern Australia would also sink. Hence, on 8 January 2020, we began to predict that in 2-7 weeks time, rain, hail and snow would contain the bushfires. Afterwards, our group of volunteers flew to Australia from Singapore on 12 January 2020 to partake in extinguishing the fires. On 14 January, just as we were about to depart from Australia, the BOM announced that there would be a sudden "rain bomb" the following day, on 15 January.

True enough, continuous rainfall ensued, and hail even descended in many regions. Flash floods occurred due to the downpours, but the heavy rains also replenished many of the country's water-scarce reservoirs. The rains also gave the firefighters their much needed respite. Finally, our prediction regarding the bushfires came true once again -- within 7 weeks, the bushfires were completely under control. On 13 February, the media began reporting about Australia's fires coming under control for the first time in many months, and that the miracle rains saved Australia. The media and meteorologists also started theorising on the reasons behind the abnormal weather changes. New South Wales even reported that this was their wettest February since 2012 when rainfall was 104% higher than in average years, and it was the wettest month since September 2016. Victoria's rainfall was also 65% higher. These were beyond meteorologists' expectations.

The above are short introductions of some of our disaster mitigation efforts. We are a non-profit group that does not seek any benefits. We only wish to put our extraordinary abilities to good use and help resolve global disaster crises. If you would like to understand how we achieve this, we are more than happy to share.

The news of flooding in Kyushu, Japan, worried us. In April 2020, we predicted that Japan and China (East China Sea regions) would experience catastrophic water-related disasters. In May 2020, we received another prediction that Japan would face a similar disaster following the appearance of the crimson moon. The proverbial crimson moon was confirmed to be the strawberry moon in June 2020, and this phenomenon was observed by many across the world. Judging from the current torrential rains, the plum rain season this year is expected to bring disastrous floods in Japan. According to the prediction, this flooding episode is only a prelude to the "water-related disaster" described in the prediction verse. In fact, we are more worried about the upcoming weather situations in the East China Sea.

In view of the above, we hope to aid your country to mitigate rainstorms by working closely according to your meteorologists' forecasts and flood warnings. They could surely help us understand the most appropriate locations for interventions. We do not ask for anything in return. We only wish to contribute and ensure the safety of the lives and property of the people.

To be honest, compelled by our worries and a sense of urgency, we relied on our own analyses and began to reduce rainfall in Kyushu at 12 pm on 10 July. We predicted that

between 10-16 July, rainfall in this region would reduce, preventing further rains from devastating the area.

Nonetheless, the issue that troubles us most is the lack of real-time data from the affected regions to enable us to lend aid in the most effective manner. This is detrimental to our efforts. Moreover, Japan is a relatively large country. It is challenging for us in Singapore and Malaysia to obtain the most updated and real-time information. We can only rely on weather forecasts from online sources and news reports. Hence, moving forward, if we are able to obtain your help and support with accurate and precise information about which areas to intervene and reduce rainfall, our efforts can yield much more efficient results and save more people.

As an old saying goes, "It is better to believe than to disbelieve". Time is of the essence. We hope that you can contact us as soon as possible so as to not let the opportunity to save more people slip by! We will do our utmost to be of service. Thank you!
